

Advice for Public Attendees at Full Council

1. If you plan to attend the Full Council meeting on 21 July 2021 the Council requests that you undertake a lateral flow test and receive a negative test result to show you do not have Covid before you attend the meeting. You may be asked to show this result in some form before entering the building.
