



- · Importance of corporate and political buy-in

People

- Strong culture of car use response to an unsupportive environment
- · Addressing the needs and concerns of different groups
- · Community engagement is key to building support and ownership over key measures

- 20 minute neighbourhood concept and wider connectivity between wards and public transport
