512	The Un-Lawful use of Parker Road Recreational Field and alleys/walkways and right of way surrounding Parker Road, Belmont Road, Castle Road, Rosebery Road and London Road	5 October 2018	Mrs R Stammers	It is the Council's opinion that the applicant has correctly sought permissions, the planning application was correctly processed and accords with legislation. The Council has therefore not acted unlawfully or inappropriately.
513	Against the noise of barking dogs at 49 Lea Road, Chadwell St Mary, Grays, RM16 4DD	22 October 2018	Mr Taylor	Officers have observed the barking of dogs as alleged by the petitioners and served notice on the occupier under the relevant legislation. Observations are continuing and should a recurrence of the barking be witnessed by the Council's officers the appropriate prosecution will be commenced. To date no barking after the notice came into effect has been witnessed by officers.
514	Calling for the pedestrian crossings in Ship Lane and High Street to be upgraded to Pelican crossings with an additional Pelican added to Stifford Road, creating a three way controlled scheme.	31 October 2018	Councillor Smith	The Transport Development team have drafted a number of design proposals in order to address the issues. These options will be discussed in detail with the ward members so that an agreed approach can be identified and taken forward for wider consultation with local residents and business in December.
515	Call for Thurrock Council to review its Permit Parking Area (PPA) in Hobart Road. This has left inadequate parking for all residents of Freemantle House, Brisbane House and Tasmania House.	31 October 2018	Councillor Allen	The provision of additional parking spaces to support residents in this location will require an allocation of Thurrock Council Housing land. This has been discussed with the Council's Housing team and locations considered to ascertain if additional parking spaces can be provided. There are another 2

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				<p>car parks in addition to the car park situated next to Tasmania House, that provide in excess of another 40 spaces. These are located on Leicester Road and on Hobart Road (opposite no 9 Hobart Road) that residents living in the High rise flats could use. If the land is found to be suitable a revised plan to identify additional parking will be progressed and residents will be informed. Initial indications identify that 12 additional parking spaces could be implemented within the land that has been identified. A scheme to deliver these parking spaces is likely to commence in January/February 2019.</p>
516	<p>The residents of Grays are opposed to Thurrock Council's new interpretation of the parking restrictions on Lodge Lane which go against the agreement reached in 2005.</p>	31 October 2018	Councillor C Kent	<p>The Transport Development Team have commenced a review of the Traffic Regulation Order covering Lodge Lane and potential options will be considered. These options will be prepared for consideration and action as appropriate over the next few weeks.</p>
