<p>Functions determined by Council:</p> <p>To review and scrutinise matters relating to –</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. the formulation of policies and strategies to govern the Council’s housing activities 2. housing needs issues, including allocations, & tenancy reform 3. service issues, including the repairs service, local budgets, customer profiling & personalised services (particularly for older residents) 4. development, including Housing Revenue Account financing, new build and regeneration of the estates. 5. the Council’s functions in relation to the fitness and improvement of private sector housing, including, the registrations of landlords, standards within the sector and its use as temporary accommodation. 6. the Housing Revenue Account budget 7. homelessness and travellers 8. the provision, planning and performance of all housing functions
