585	In respect of a traffic assessment on Stifford Road, South Ockenden. With a view to implement double yellow lines, to prevent potentially dangerous parking. Residents have raised concerns around potentially dangerous parking by Target Car Sales on Stifford Road, South Ockenden, in the ward of Belhus.	20 March 2024	Council	Cllr Polley	An assessment of the area has been undertaken and the practice of verge parking outside Target Car Sales has been noted. To address this issue a statutory consultation on a proposal to “At Any Time” waiting restrictions (double yellow lines) in the vicinity of 89-103 Stifford Road will be programmed to commence at the end of May. The consultation will run for a period of 21 days. Residents will of course comment on the proposals during the consultation period. We are ready to proceed with the agreed process. Consultation will commence at the beginning of July.

587	<p>Reduce the speed limit from 40mph to 30mph on Woodview between Blackshots Roundabout and to just before King Edward Drive. It is a 30mph limit on the roundabout and as you get to King Edward Drive there is a small turning on the left where motorists leave and enter, this is becoming dangerous.</p>	20 March 2024	Council	Cllr Redsell	<p>The accident record for Woodview has been checked and fortunately no accidents have been recorded within the last 5 years. However, having reviewed the infrastructure and the surrounding environment, a statutory consultation will be undertaken proposing the reduction in speed limit from 40 mph to 30mph. The consultation will be programmed to commence in June this year. In the meantime a traffic survey will be undertaken which will provide valuable data for use during the consultation period. Waiting on the results of the speed survey before we consult with the Police for their support of the reduction of the speed limit.</p>
